

# "I think I'm pregnant...now what?"

Have you taken a pregnancy test?

*Pregnancy testing can be done using over the counter test kits or by a medical provider. Check out these options:*

- Visit the University Health Center (UHC) to purchase a low cost pregnancy test at the pharmacy, get walk in testing at the lab, or schedule an appointment with a provider for pregnancy testing.
- Stop by the UMD Help Center (3rd floor of South Campus Dining Hall) for a walk-in pregnancy test.
- Purchase a test at a local pharmacy or store, including campus convenience stores
- Schedule an appointment with your healthcare provider

**\*For most accurate results, the best time to take a pregnancy test is the first day of your missed period with a sample of first morning urine.\***

*Have you had unprotected sex within the past 3 days/ 72 hours? If you want to try to prevent pregnancy, over the counter Emergency Contraception (EC), like Plan B, may be right for you. This type of EC is available at:*

- The University Health Center (UHC) through Reproductive Health and the pharmacy
- Select campus convenience stores
- Over the counter at many pharmacies.

Ella (prescription EC) is effective for up to 5 days after unprotected sex and is available by appointment at the UHC.

**Interested in birth control options to prevent future pregnancy?**

- Free birth control consultations - if you're not sure which method is right for you.

- Birth control starts and refills (if you know what method you want)
  - Call Reproductive Health at 301-314-8190 or go to myuhc.umd.edu
- Free safer sex supplies grab-and-go style on the ground floor of the UHC
